“CYBERBULLYING AND SOCIAL MEDIA” PARENT PROGRAM:

More and more schools nationwide are requesting a parent program focused on the topics of “Cyberbullying and Social Media”. In today’s technologically-driven world, this talk is perfect for addressing ways to help our kids and adults navigate responsibly online. Along with taking a comprehensive look at mental health among youth this presentation will also:

- Touch on the main themes and stories shared with youth during the ‘Mr. Peace’ primary “Bullying” assembly (i.e., Appreciate other’s differences; See everyone as human beings; Look at one’s heart first; Hurt people hurt people, but healed people heal people; Have courage to do what’s right; All of us are unique miracles, etc.)
- Provide insight on how modifying one’s own mobile device habits can significantly influence how children will ultimately utilize their smart phones, tablets, etc.
- Review statistics involving the trends of electronics addiction and social media usage
- Explore the gravity of the epidemic of (cyber)bullying and solutions for how we can counter it (i.e., the good vs. the bad of social media -> can be positive if used wisely)
- Offer practical tools for online safety, which parents can implement with their kids moving forward (i.e., “Resource” link made available post-program for all attendees)

Schools generally schedule this session before school begins or after school hours, with student assemblies prior to or following the workshop so everyone is on the same page.
